1. By way of present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case bearing FIR No.32, dated 26.05.2021, registered under Sections 21-C, 22-C and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala.
2. In the present case, the petitioner has been implicated for the alleged recovery of 14000 intoxicant tablets of “*Tramadol*” effected from her kitchen.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, from ASI Bali Ram, who is present in Court informs that only one witness namely, SHO Paramjit Singh remains to be examined and thus, the trial is at its fag end, which is now fixed for 06.02.2024.
4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed.
