1. By way of the present petition filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short 'the Act'), petitioner has approached this Court for appointment of an Arbitrator in terms of Clause 11 of Lease Deed dated 10.11.2017, Annexure P-2, to adjudicate the dispute between the parties.
2. Upon notice, respondent has appeared through counsel. Upon instructions from Mr. J.S. Negi, Manager, HSIIDC, counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent does not have any objection, in case, an arbitrator is appointed.
3. Accordingly, petition is allowed.

Mr. Justice Rajiv Sharma (Retd.), Former Judge of Punjab and Haryana High Court, House No. 505 (Backside First Floor), Sector 36-B, Chandigarh 160036, Mobile No. 9816700002, is requested to act as an Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the parties, subject to compliance of statutory requirements.
5. Parties are directed to appear before the learned Arbitrator on date, time and place to be fixed by the Arbitrator at his convenience.
6. Needless to mention, parties will be at liberty to raise all the claims/defences/counter claims/pleas including that of limitation before the Arbitrator.
