1.        The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sahinta, 2023 (B.N.S.S) seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.633 dated 08.08.2024 under Sections 333/140(3)/115(2)/3 (5)/351(2) ( Section 74 of BNSS added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.

2.        On 11.09.2024, following order was passed:

*"The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0633 dated 08.08.2024 under Sections 333, 140(3), 115(2), 3(5), 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita and later on added Section 74 of BNS registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia*



*contends that the complainant has solemnized the marriage with Kxx who is a relative of the petitioner against the wishes of her parents. All the three co-accused of the petitioner are in custody presently. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation. It is further informed that the matter stands compromised between the parties. The affidavit of Tarun Kumar (complainant) and affidavit of Kirti is submitted in the Court today, which is taken on record. Copies of these affidavits be supplied to the learned State counsel.*

*Status report by way of affidavit of Nayab Singh, HPS, DSP, HQ, Karnal on behalf of the State has been taken on record.*

*Mr. Gyan Parkash Saini, Advocate has filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2 and confirms the factum of compromise between the parties.*

*Adjourned to 02.12.2024.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within ten days and in the event of arrest, he shall be released on interim bail, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Area Magistrate, subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, and also subject to the following conditions:-*

- (i) That the petitioner shall further make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.*
- (ii) That the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.*
- (iii) That the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Trial Court/CJM concerned."*



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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties and a petition bearing CRM-M-55541-2024 in this regard is also pending before this Court for 30.01.2025.
4. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Sultan Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 11.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.
4. Keeping in view the statement made by learned State Counsel and in view of the compromise between the parties, the order dated 11.09.2024, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
