MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.59 dated 09.08.2023 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Women, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab.

2. Vide order dated 05.09.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation and on 29.11.2023, petitioner was directed to rejoin the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 05.09.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
