1. The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is falsely involved in criminal case having FIR No.52 dated 07.07.2024 under Section 21 (c) NDPS Act. It is further submitted that the petitioner has made prayer to direct the police authorities concerned to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the said criminal case and to take into consideration CD Annexure P-2 containing video and photographs taken at the time when the petitioner was illegally taken away from his house at about 12 noon on 07.07.2024.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and has not disputed the fact regarding registration of aforesaid criminal case against the present petitioner. He further submits that petitioner was arrested and is presently lodged in jail. The State counsel further submits that no representation of the petitioner is pending with the



police authorities.

4. Faced with this situation, the counsel for the petitioner submits that direction be given to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation, which the petitioner is going to file within a period of next 10 days.

5. In light of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case with direction that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within next 10 days, the same is to be considered and decided by respondent No.3 in accordance with law, within a period of 4 weeks thereof.

6. The petition stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
