1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) passed in Civil Misc Appeal No.14 of 2021 passed by the Additional District Judge, Panipat as well as order dated 31.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) in Civil Suit No.132/2021 passed by the Civil Judge, Panipat dismissing the application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC filed by respondent No.1.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide judgement dated 26.05.2023 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Panipat, it has been recorded that the matter has been compromised and accordingly, the suit has been dismissed as withdrawn and in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
