In the present petition, petitioner is claiming benefit of the service rendered by him in the Government aided institution, which benefit has not been extended towards the fixation of pay as well as for the grant of pensionary benefits, which law has already been settled by this Court in **LPA No.1853-2018, titled as State of Punjab vs. Sushil Kumar Sharma and others** hence, the respondents are under an obligation to grant the petitioner said benefit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in legal notice dated 09.06.2024 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

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On the asking of the Court, Mr. Satnam Preet Singh Chauhan, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, legal notice dated 09.06.2024 (Annexure P/6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
