JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release his provident fund.
2. Mr. R.S. Dhull, Advocate for the petitioner submits that petitioner retired on 30.04.2010 and he had worked with respondent No.2- Chandigarh Sports Council from 01.08.2000 to 30.04.2010. There was mistake on the part of employer with respect to deduction/deposit of provident fund. The employer has deposited provident fund though late.
3. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submit that they have already deposited provident fund of petitioner with authorities and money is lying with authorities since 2015. They have further cleared all the



objections raised by the authorities.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that Competent Authority would look into grievance of the petitioner. If all the documents have already been submitted, the amount would be released within 3 months from today. If the petitioner has not submitted documents, intimation within 1 month shall be sent to the petitioner.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
