**********HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)**

1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, contempt proceedings are sought to be initiated against the respondents towards alleged willful disobedience of order dated 18.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP No.11705 of 2024.

2. Learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the needful qua the claims/entitlements of the petitioners has been done, however, release of payments shall be carried out within a period of three months from today.

3. In view of aforesaid stand taken by the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.

5. However, in case, any claim of the petitioners still survives, they would be at liberty to raise their claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from the release of payments, which shall

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be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioners within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondents, the officer concerned would be liable to pay cost(s) of Rs.50,000/- to each of the petitioners from his/her own pocket.

6. Also, it is made clear that in an eventuality, wherein the petitioners are compelled to approach this Court seeking revival of the contempt petition, the respondent(s) shall bear the additional cost(s) of Rs.1,00,000/- towards litigation expenses incurred by the petitioners.
