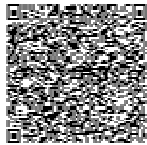

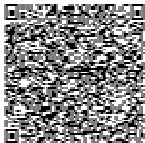

MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of the private respondents and for conducting fair and impartial inquiry on her application dated 16.07.2024 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the very outset, learned State counsel has submitted that as per instructions received by him, the application/representation (Annexure P-1) as moved by the petitioner before respondent No. 5-Incharge, Police Post Mattewara, Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana stands filed, since as medico-legal report, no injury was found on the person of the petitioner or her

daughter and there was only complaint of pain. It is also submitted that in the aforesaid application, neither any threat to life and liberty of the petitioner or any of her family members has been pleaded nor any threat perception has been found during inquiry.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as no further orders are called for in the matter. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to avail her alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
