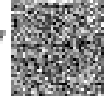

AMARJOT BHATTI. J.(Oral)

1. Petitioner Raghvir Singh has filed petition under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.118 dated 23.07.2024, under Section 108 of BNS, registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.
2. As per the facts of the case complainant-Arshdeep Singh stated that they are two brothers, his elder brother is namely Rajdeep Singh, and one younger sister namely Sukhpreet Kaur, they had 05 acres of land. Rajdeep Singh had submitted his file for going abroad. His father had sold 10 kanals of land for sending his son abroad. Visa of his brother was not received. There was a dispute between his father Jasvir Singh and Raghvir Singh. As a result, Raghvir Singh lodged a complaint against his brother Rajdeep Singh and father Jasvir Singh and one FIR was registered under Section 323 of IPC. Raghvir Singh started saying



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that he would teach a lesson to him, as now his son Rajdeep Singh will not be able to go abroad on account of said FIR. Because of this reason his father was mentally harassed and humiliated, and due to continuous harassment his father Jasvir Singh committed suicide by consuming poison. With these allegations, present FIR was registered and investigation was carried out.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that his arrest was stayed subject to the joining of investigation vide order dated 30.08.2024. He was falsely implicated in this case. In pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is ready to abide by its terms and conditions.

4. Bail petition is opposed by learned counsel representing the complainant, taking the stand that due to the harassment caused by the petitioner his father Jasvir Singh ended up his life by consuming poison, therefore, he is not entitled to be released on anticipatory bail.

5. On the other hand, status report filed by the respondent-State is taken on record. It is confirmed that present petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any other purpose.

6. I have considered the aforesaid factual position, as referred above, present petitioner has already joined the investigation. FIR of another case will be decided on its own merits. No purpose would be served by sending the petitioner behind the bars. Petitioner is ready to abide by the conditions of bail order. Therefore, without expressing my mind upon the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner–Raghvir Singh is allowed. He be not arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of



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Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join the investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482(2) of BNSS.

- 7. Petition is accordingly accepted.
- 8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
