1. On 29.8.2024, this Court had passed the hereinafter extracted
order, upon the instant petition:-

“1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 482 of the BNSS, the petitioner has sought the concession of his being enlarged on anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.34 dated 03.08.2024, under Sections 126(2), 109, 351(2), 324(2), 324(6) and 3(5) of the BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Kheri Naudh Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. In his asking for the relief (supra), learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of no injury, and even as per the allegations in the FIR (supra), the

petitioner has given blows, which hit on the pillar of the car.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Pardeep Bajaj, DAG, Punjab, waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent-State, whereas, Mr. H.S. Deol, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the complainant and files his duly executed Power of Attorney, in his favour, which is taken on record.

5. List on 03.10.2024.

6. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and to appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bond to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

2. Considering the fact that now the petitioner has been involved in another case FIR No.0189 dated 2.10.2024, registered under Sections 103(1), 191(3) and 190 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition.

3. **Dismissed** as withdrawn.
