JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to decide her representation dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-13).
2. The petitioner claims that since July' 2021, she is working as Warden with respondent. The respondent abruptly terminated her on the ground that she is keeping her son at night time in the hostel. The child is 6 years old, thus, she has no option except to keep him with herself.
3. Mr. G.S. Ghuman, Advocate submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed, if respondents are directed to consider her representation dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-13) in a time bound manner.



4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Mayank Sharma, Advocate who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents- U.T. Chandigarh and waives service.
6. With consent of learned counsel for the parties, the case is taken up for final disposal.
7. Mr. Mayank Sharma, Advocate submits that competent authority would look into the matter and pass an appropriate order.
8. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider representation dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-13) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order within 10 days from today.
