1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the conclusion of proceedings emanating from criminal trial.

2. Mr. Ishan Gupta, Advocate for the petitioner submits that grievance of petitioner would be redressed, if he is not compelled to put forth his defence in departmental proceedings till the filing of police report in FIR No.28 dated 09.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered against him.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab submits that investigation in aforesaid FIR is almost complete except question of voice sample. He assures that petitioner would not be compelled to put forth his defence in departmental proceedings till the filing of police report.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid statement.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
6. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
