1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 16.01.2023 passed in CWP-5600-2022.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Hosyar Singh, HCS, SDO (Civil), Rewari-cum-Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Rewari, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 16.01.2023 passed in CWP-5600-2022 has since been complied, and the application filed by the petitioner under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands Act, stands decided.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
