[1] On 06.09.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. Sherry K. Singla, Advocate, for the petitioners.
Ms. Svaneel Jaswal, Additional A.G., Haryana.

Inter alia contends that complainant alleged that a sum of Rs.4,54,896/- was found to be deducted from her bank accounts and accused persons have committed fraud with the complainant. The co-accused/main accused Sanjeet Kumar Gupta has already been granted regular bail by this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 06.07.2023. He submits that complainant has also entered into a compromise with the main accused and on the basis of settlement regular bail was granted to the main accused.

Notice of motion.

On advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Haryana.

Adjourned to 22.11.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioners shall join investigation, as and when required by the Investigating Agency and subject to their reporting to the Investigating Officer within two weeks from today, no coercive steps qua arrest of the petitioners shall be taken. In case, their arrest is required to be caused, petitioners shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer till the next date of hearing on their furnishing personal bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall also abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

[2] Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Vishal Saini, has informed this Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 06.09.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[3] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 06.09.2023, whereby the petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, they shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
