1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 27.02.2023 passed in CWP-3945-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 27.02.2023 passed in CWP-3945-2023 has since been complied with and legal notice of the petitioners has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 24.11.2023 (Annexure R-1).
3. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
