1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for partly quashing the order dated 30.11.2012 (Annexure P-17), whereby respondent No.3 has ordered a fresh denovo enquiry against the petitioner by quashing the earlier enquiry report dated 29.03.2005; for quashing the consequent exparte denovo enquiry dated 19.03.2013 (Annexure P-20) and for quashing the order dated 01.01.2016 (Annexure P-24), whereby the recovery of Rs.1,13,162/- along with interest @ 14.79% per annum totaling Rs.3,96,051/- has been upheld by respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has unfortunately died, and his legal representatives are not forthcoming.
