AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner – Jashanpreet Singh @ Bhindu @ Jaskaran Singh has filed petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.0015 dated 08.03.2024, under Sections 307, 323, 427, 506, 458, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise dated 06.07.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. As per the facts of case, Avtar Singh complainant gave his statement to the police that on 07.03.2024 at about 9:15 PM, after taking dinner, the family members went to sleep. At about 9:40 PM, they heard noise of motorcycle. He got up and opened the gate of his house and saw persons on motorcycle and tractor went towards the bus stand. After some time, they returned back. The complainant stopped them and tried to make them understand. On this, Karamjot Singh alias Ghug and Amanpreet



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Singh alias Bau got down from the farm track tractor. They protested as to why he stopped them. People in the neighbourhood also started gathering there. Balvir Singh, Joginder Singh, Gurwinder Singh etc. also tried to make them understand. Gurmukh Singh alias Gumma came on motorcycle and started arguments. Karamjit Singh moved his tractor towards the gate of his house with an intention to kill Nirmal Kaur. She was saved with great difficulty. After some time, said persons came armed with deadly weapons in front of his house. Gurmukh Singh alias Gumma attacked his younger brother Nirmal Singh with sharp edged weapon hitting him on his head and leg. Jaskaran Singh alias Bhendu, Jasveer Singh alias Bau armed with swords threatened to kill them. They closed the door of their house. Other 10-12 persons started brick-bating in their house breaking their windowpanes and damaged their car. They raised *lalkaras*. On gathering of several persons, they left the spot with their respective weapons. The entire incident was recorded in CCTV camera. Later on, his brother Nirmal Singh and his wife Nirmal Kaur were taken to CHC Singhpur for treatment. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that matter has been compromised with the complainant party. Copy of compromise deed is Annexure P-2. One petition for quashing of FIR is also filed i.e. CRM-M-35511-2024. Copy of order dated 05.08.2024 is Annexure P-3. It is prayed that his regular bail petition may be allowed.

4. Bail petition is opposed by learned counsel representing State. Facts narrated in the FIR are confirmed in the status report. Present petitioner is specifically named. However, it is confirmed that petitioner



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along with others have filed petition for quashing of FIR. Considering the allegations, he is not entitled to be released on bail.

6. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record. As referred above, present petitioner has already joined the investigation. He was arrested and is behind the bars since 12.03.2024. As referred above, matter is compromised with complainant and the parties have filed petition for quashing of present FIR. No purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in the light of aforesaid factual position, without going on the merits of the case, regular bail petition filed by petitioner – Jashanpreet Singh @ Bhindu @ Jaskaran Singh is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Judge concerned.
