RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 18.09.1996 passed by this Court in RSA-699-1991.
2. It is not even in dispute that the respondents were not originally the party to the Regular Second Appeal. Although, they subsequently succeeded the original respondents, however, it is the assertion of the respondents that they were not aware of the order of status quo.
3. There is nothing on record to show that the petitioner had ever intimated the respondents qua the interim order; before the respondents had executed the sale deed. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, the dismissal of the present petition shall not be deemed to have taken away the right of the petitioner to raise his appropriate grievance before the Appellate Court, but in accordance with law.
