1. Appellant – Sahil @ Shallu has filed the instant appeal against impugned order dated 03.07.2023 whereby learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar dismissed the anticipatory bail application filed by the appellant in FIR No.110 dated 09.07.2016 under Sections 307, 506, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act and Section 3 (1)A and 3 (2) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for appellant argued that considering the facts and circumstances of the case, present appellant was granted interim bail vide order dated 06.09.2023 by the Coordinate Bench. In pursuance of this order, present appellant has been granted interim bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar and also produced receipt regarding deposit of



cost of Rs.25,000/- which has been imposed in the aforesaid order.

Appellant is already facing trial without any fail, therefore, interim bail granted in his favour may be confirmed.

3. Learned counsel representing State confirmed the aforesaid factual position.

4. I have considered the arguments and documents relied upon by counsel for the appellant. Present appellant was declined anticipatory bail in aforesaid FIR by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide impugned order dated 03.07.2023. Consequently, present appeal has been filed. As per order dated 06.09.2023, present appellant has already furnished bail bonds and surety bonds and is now facing trial.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by sending him behind the bars. Therefore, appeal filed by appellant is accepted and impugned order dated 03.07.2023 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar is set aside. Interim bail granted vide order dated 06.09.2023 by the Coordinate Bench stands confirmed with same terms and conditions.
