1. By way of present revision petition, petitioner has laid the challenge to the order dated 24.07.2024 passed by Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Garhshankar, in an execution application bearing No.EXE/56/2018 whereby, the non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner.

2. Petitioner is judgment-debtor who is facing execution proceedings with respect to decree dated 16.01.2014 passed by Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Garhshankar. The decree against the petitioner has attained finality in the execution proceedings initiated by decree-holder and non-bailable warrants have been issued.

3. After arguing for sometime, counsel for the petitioner submits that only relief he prays for is that keeping in view the old age of the petitioner, he be treated with mercy.

4. *Per contra*, counsel for the decree-holder submits that for more than 10 years, the petitioner has evaded money decree and thus, he does not deserve any relief.



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5. In view of the above, I find no merit in the present case and the same is dismissed. This Court is of the opinion that the petitioner will be dealt with in accordance with law.
