1. This is the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.472 dated 17.05.2024, registered under Section 406/420 IPC & Section 10/24 of the Immigration Act, at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.
2. This Court vide detailed order dated 14.08.2024 has dismissed the earlier petition filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail. Needless to say that the petitioner was granted interim protection in that petition, however, the same was rejected vide order 14.08.2024 for the reasons recorded therein. There is no change in the circumstances.
3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in **G.R. Ananda Babu Vs. State of Tamil Nadu, 2021(1) RCR (Criminal) 843** has held that successive anticipatory bail applications ought not to be entertained on specious ground of 'Changed Circumstances'.
4. In view of the law settled, the present petition being not maintainable, is hereby dismissed.
5. Nothing said herein shall be treated as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
