This is an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act seeking condonation of delay of 41 days in filing the present appeal.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 41 days in filing the present appeal is hereby condoned.

FAO-409-2022 (O&M)

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant(s) in proportion as already awarded by the MACT.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.7,50,000/- in the name of appellant(s) with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within six weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9 % per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The

concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be consigned to record room.
