The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the payment of various constructions materials i.e. Bricks, Sand, Iron material, Cement, Tiles etc. provided by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioner has submitted representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.6-Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Kot Ise Khan, District Moga but no action has been taken by the respondent-authorities.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, Asstt. A.G. Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.6-Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Kot Ise Khan, District Moga is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.6-Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Kot Ise Khan, District Moga to consider and decide the representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in his favour within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
