Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that considering the fact that the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner falls within the ambit of commercial quantity. Therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, however, a direction may be issued to the learned trial Court concerned to expedite the recording of the prosecution witnesses.

The innocuous and *bona fide* prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is hereby accepted.

The instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however with a direction upon the learned trial Court concerned, to make efforts, to expedite the examination of the prosecution witnesses.
