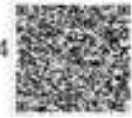

PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0161 dated 23.09.2023, registered for the offence punishable under Section 306 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.
2. As per allegations levelled in the FIR, it has been alleged as under:-

“Copy of statement, "Statement of Paramjit Kaur @ Tallo wife of Late Sukhpal Singh @ Pal son of Bant Singh resident of Lakhiwala, aged about 47 years, mobile no.90410-25354. Stated that I am resident of above mentioned address. Doing domestic work. About 22 years ago, I have performed marriage with Sukhpal Singh @ Pal son of Bant Singh resident of Lakhiwala. We have five children. My husband Sukhpal Singh aged about 49 years was doing the work of labour. Yesterday on 22.09.2023, at about 8 O'clock in the morning me and my husband Sukhpal Singh went to Packa Canal Water course near Bus Stand Lakhiwala for the work of



Narega. Rajinder Singh @ Babbu son of Ajit Singh son of Atma Singh resident of Lakhiwala was supervising the work of Narega. At about 8:15 AM when the presence of we labrouers have been marked, at that time there was a gathering of about 25 male and female labourers of Narega, then Rajinder Singh @ Babbu in the presence of all of them asked my husband to go to S.C. Community Hall for work of Narega because work was going on at that place also. On which my husband said that he will not do work there but he will do work at the water course only. On asking this by my husband, Rajinder Singh @ Babbu above twisted his arm and gave slaps and fist blows and Rajinder Singh said that you ran away to home. On listening this my husband Sukhpal Singh took a spade and went to home and did not return to work. I was working there because I was on work. Then in the evening at about 4:45 O'clock Baljinder Singh @ Mungri son of our neibhours came to take me from work who said me to come to home as there is some urgent work. When I came to home and saw that the dead body of my husband Sukhpal Singh was lying in our courtyard. Later on, I came to know that as Rajinder Singh @ Babbu above insulted my husband Sukhpal Singh by giving slaps and fist blows in front of Narega labourers, my husband feeling insulted of that strangulated himself by putting a rope in his neck and hanging himself with a forest tree in the cremation ground of village and ended his life. Action be taken against Rajinder Singh Babbu. Statement recorded to you, heard, which is correct. xxxx”

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant stands examined, but has not supported the case of the prosecution.
4. Counsel for the State does not dispute the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.



6. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
