Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita Act, 2023 for quashing the Kalandra/Order dated 12.07.2024 vide which the proceedings under Section 145(8) Cr.P.C. has been imposed upon the land and receiver has been directed not to allow any party to interfere in the land in dispute; the proceedings under Section 145(8) Cr.P.C. are wrong, illegal, deliberate and the same are liable to be quashed. Further prayer has been made for staying the operation of the order dated 12.07.2024 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 03.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) before the Superintendent of Police (Rural) Amritsar, District Amritsar but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if his representation dated 03.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) is decided in a time bound manner.
