1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 03.07.2015 passed in CWP-28642-2013.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Anish Kumar, Executive Engineer, Office XEN (Op.), Divn. DHBVN, Hansi, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 03.07.2015 passed in CWP-28642-2013 has since been complied with and necessary payment alongwith interest has been made to the petitioner through cheque as mentioned in Annexure R-2.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
