1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 29.09.2017 passed in CWP-25215-2012.

2. Pursuant to previous order dated 15.05.2024, costs has been deposited.

3. Compliance report on behalf of the respondents, as well as, receipt of costs, have been filed today in the Court. The same are taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order 29.09.2017 passed in CWP-25215-2012 has been complied with; promotion has been granted to the petitioner and an amount of Rs.3,01,993/-



by way of demand draft bearing No.391730 issued in favour of the petitioner has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. Copy of said demand draft is annexed with the aforesaid compliance report.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
