1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 praying for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner at the instance of respondents No.5 to 9 in the name of false implication in some criminal case by exceeding their power. It is further prayed to issue directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to ensure the security of life and liberty of the petitioner, which is in eminent danger at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9 by taking appropriate action on the representation, dated 23.08.2024, Annexure P-4, given by the petitioner.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Gurpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Mansa, District Mansa has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, in the Court today, same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated his arguments that the petitioner is unnecessarily being harassed.



4. However, learned State counsel refutes the same and has submitted that one person namely, Inderjeet Singh, accused in FIR was suspected who has been given shelter by the petitioner and it is only on that account the police has reached the house of the petitioner. However, as on date, the petitioner is not required.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
