1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 16.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) to the SHO Police Station Kotwali, Zirakpur, SAS Nagar, Mohali and he shall be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction

to the SHO Police Station Kotwali, Zirakpur, SAS Nagar, Mohali-respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 16.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
