The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to not harass the petitioner and to initiate proceedings against the private respondents as the cognizable offence has been reported by way of written representation dated 22.07.2024 bearing UID No.385458 and to conclude the inquiry in fair and expeditious manner without being influenced by the private respondents (Annexure P-1).

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that the FIR on the basis of the complaint made by the petitioner has already been registered and FIR number has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner in the Court today itself.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the jurisdictional Magistrate in case anything survives further in the matter.
