SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. Status report, by way of affidavit of Bikramjit Singh Brar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Rajpura, District Patiala (Punjab) has been filed by learned State counsel in the Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel opposite.

2. The relevant of abovesaid status report reads as under:

“7. That the complainant further stated that since the matter is pending before the Hon'ble Court from a long time, and no justice is delivered to the complainant, hence, the complainant requested that the matter be got inquired through some senior officer in the rank of Superintendent of Police Patiala as the petitioner Gurcharanjit Singh is making false allegations against the then Deputy Superintendent of Police Circle Rajpura and case be registered against accused persons to deliver justice to the complainant.

8. That on receipt of application of the complainant Parwinder Singh the application was marked as 4481/peshi dated 25.05.2024 and the Senior Superintendent of Police



Patiala marked the same to Superintendent of Police Investigation to enquire the matter and to submit report.

9. That the report of Superintendent of Police Investigation, Patiala is awaited and further necessary action in accordance with law will be initiated as per report.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Lal, has also submitted that the inquiry which has been now marked to SP (Investigation), Patiala shall be undertaken in accordance with law.
4. Faced with the abovesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take appropriate steps/recourse in law, in case occasion so arises.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
