1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for protection of the life of the petitioner, who is seriously ill and is unable to move and is confined in Central Jail, Goindwal Sahib in case FIR No.8 dated 23.01.2024 under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and sections 21C, 27A, 61, 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel inter alia contends that the petitioner, who is lodged in Central Jail, Goindwal Sahib, is seriously ill, however, his medical treatment is not satisfactory. He submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to the jail authorities, concerned to get him medically treated from a good medical facility at the earliest. Learned counsel further submits that a representation in the said regard



(Annexure P-4) dated 27.08.2024 has also been given to the official respondents but in vain.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 – Superintendent of Central Jail, Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran to look into the representation dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest.
