AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Harbans Kaur has filed instant petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India directing respondents No.1 to 3 to provide security of life and liberty to petitioner as well as her family from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8 and to take legal action against them as a result of which DDR No.27 dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) has been registered and further using caste based names with an intention to insult her.

2. As per previous order dated 03.09.2024, status report was called for which has been filed by the respondent- State and same is taken on record. As per para Nos.3 and 4 of the status report, matter is enquired by the police and in the said incident no cognizable offence under Section 323 IPC was committed, as a result DDR No.27 dated 03.04.2024 was registered at Police Station Salem Tabri which is Annexure P-1. It is

further reported that representation (Annexure P-3) addressed to DGP, Punjab was also considered. It was revealed that both the parties belonged to scheduled caste, as such no further action was required.

3. In view of the aforesaid status report, police has already taken appropriate steps. No further action is required. Therefore, present petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioners that she can seek appropriate remedy as available under law.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
