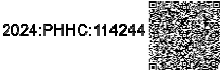
TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional ten per cent of the basic pay with dearness allowance to the petitioner in compliance of the amendment dated 13.04.2022, Annexure P-11, in the Teachers Transfer Policy 2016 (further amended in 2017 and 2023), since he has been posted in district Nuh (Mewat).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 11.08.2024, Annexure P-15, in a specified period.

Chahal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 11.08.2024, will be decided by respondent No.3-Director General, Department of Elementary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.
