The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 for conducting fair and impartial inquiry on the complaint made by him.

[2] Upon notice, a status report dated 03.12.2023 on behalf of respondent-State stands filed, wherein it is mentioned that an FIR No. 210 dated 09.11.2023 under Section 302 of IPC stood registered against respondent No. 4 (Pinki) at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

[3] On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are few other persons who are involved in the incident as stated in the representation.

[4] Considering the fact that the FIR stands registered against the person(s) involved in the incident and the challan has already been filed, no further cause survives in the present petition.

[5] **Disposed off** accordingly.

[6] However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail the remedy against the other persons as stated in his representation, as per law.
