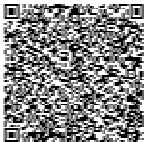

This petition has been filed for seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition) as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of the family members.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7. He further submits that they are major and solemnized marriage on 26.08.2024. They have placed on record the marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and copy of the Aadhar cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) to substantiate their claim. The petitioners have also submitted a representation dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. R.S. Thind, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice for the official respondents-State and waives service. He on

instructions from ASI-Joginder Singh, submits that statements of the petitioners have been recorded in the concerned Police Station and as per their statements, there is no threat perception to their life and liberty.

5. In view of the above submissions made by learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.
6. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
