On 19.01.2024, on behalf of the appellant statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellant to accept Rs.5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect.

Accordingly, Rs.5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only) in the name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.03.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Civil Misc. Applications seeking condonation of delay of 185 days in re-filing as well as delay of 26 days in filing the appeal are disposed of in view of the settlement.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
