

**Daily Lok Adalat****Bench No.1****509****FAO-5302-2018****MONIKA GUPTA AND ORS V/S RUBY SHARMA AND ORS**

Vide order dated 18.11.2024 on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by Rs.3,25,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by Rs.2,75,000/- and not by Rs. 3,25,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent-Insurance Company. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount of Rs.2,00,000/- would be paid to appellant No.1-Monika Gupta and the remaining enhanced amount of Rs.75,000/- would be paid to appellant No.5-Bimla Devi.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two crossed-cheques i.e. one in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh only) in the name of the appellant No.1-Monika Gupta and other in the name of appellant No.5-Bimla Devi with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 22.01.2025 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. From the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
