1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to make the payment of Rs.2,89,44,358/- qua the work of construction of Tehsil Complex including Fard Centre at Lopoke, District Amritsar executed by the petitioner, alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioner nor have they taken any action upon the said legal notice.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Brijesh, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and prays for some time to complete the instructions and file response, if necessary.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.5-The Executive



Engineer, Central Works Division No.2, PWD B&R Branch, Amritsar, is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

6. Learned Counsel for the respondents-State submits that he has no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.5-The Executive Engineer, Central Works Division No.2, PWD B&R Branch, Amritsar to consider and decide the legal notice dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. Needless to mention that upon considering the said legal notice if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.

9. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
