This is a petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 read with Section 482 of Cr.PC praying for issuance of directions to the respondent no. 2 to 4 to take appropriate action on the representation dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and for changing the Investigating Officer in FIR No. 0168 dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered U/s 323, 452 of IPC, at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural, for fair, proper & impartial investigation, and for arrest of the accused persons named in the FIR No. 0168 dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P-1), and for presentation of Challan/Final Report against the accused person, since the accused have managed the police / investigating officer of the case / FIR No. 0168 dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) due to which the police is not arresting the accused named in the FIR No. 0168 dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P-1), despite passing of period of about 7 years from the



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date of registration of the FIR, and the investigating officer wants to hush up the case / FIR No. 0168 dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) within a time bound manner.

3. Without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.3-SSP, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the counsel for the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
