SURESHWAR THAKUR, J.

1. The present appeal filed under Section 21 of the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008, is time barred and is accompanied with an application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act thus for condoning the delay of 323 days, as has occurred in the filing of the instant appeal against the declining order, as made by the learned Special Judge, on the apposite bail application preferred by the bail applicant.
