1 The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case bearing Complaint No. NACT-414-2017, under Sections 138/142 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 dated 02.06.2017 titled as 'Sandeep Yadav Vs. Dilawar Singh, as pending before the Court of Learned Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul.

2. The petitioner is facing trial for the commission of aforementioned offence in this case. He had absented himself on 20.10.2023 and his bail was cancelled. Proclamation proceedings under Section 82 of Cr.P.C were ordered to be initiated against him. On the date when the statement of executing police official regarding proclamation was being recorded, the petitioner surrendered before the Court and is in custody since then.

It is submitted that his absence was not intentional. He is in custody since 07.08.2024. He is ready to abide by the conditions as may be

imposed by this Court and will not absent himself any further.

3. The petitioner is facing trial in a private complaint case for commission of a bailable offence. He had absented himself w.e.f. 20.10.2023. However, he himself surrendered on 07.08.2024 and is in custody since then. His further detention will not serve any useful purpose.
4. Keeping in view the discussion as made above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing personal as well as surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
