The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 08.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) whereby respondent has ordered to recover a sum of Rs. 1,43,446/- on the ground that petitioner has received excess advance amount on account of LTC.

2. Mr. Anil Kumar Ahuja, Advocate, submits that petitioner has not approached the department to resolve the issue and straightway approached this Court.

3. Considering the statement of learned counsel for the respondent and amount involved, this Court does not find it appropriate to invoke its extraordinary writ jurisdiction. The petition is hereby dismissed.
