GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

1. Petitioners namely, Dharam Pal, Krishan, Shankar, Pradeep Hans, Dinesh Hans, Kailash and Sagar seek quashing of FIR No.186 dated 18.07.2024 registered under Sections 115, 126, 190, 191(3), 351(3) at Police Station Sector-6 Dharuhera, District Rewari (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise stated to have been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 04.09.2024, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Dharam Pal, Krishan, Shankar, Pradeep Hans, Dinesh Hans, Kailash and Sagar as well as of complainant/injured Krishan Kumar and Inderjeet have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

- 4. The complainant/injured Krishan Kumar and Inderjeet in their statements have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
- 5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rewari, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any coercion or undue influence.
- 6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.186 dated 18.07.2024 registered under Sections 115, 126, 190, 191(3), 351 (3) at Police Station Sector-6 Dharuhera, District Rewari (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
