AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 122 days in filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.16,50,000/- (Rupees Sixteen Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellant-Aditya.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.16,50,000/- (Rupees Sixteen Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) favouring appellant-Aditya s/o Sh. Rajesh Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 27.05.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft

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bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
