The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional honorarium of ₹10,000 per month to the petitioners in compliance of the notification dated 13.04.2022, Annexure P-2, and Teachers Transfer Policy 2023 issued on 09.08.2023, Annexure P-3, as they have been working in district Nuh (Mewat), along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make a fresh representation before the concerned respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners within two weeks from today, the same will be decided by the concerned respondents no.2 and 3-Director General, Department of Secondary/Elementary Education, as the case may be, by passing a speaking



order in accordance with law within three months of receiving the representation.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
