1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of *mandamus* for summoning the record of the case; issuance of writ of *certiorari* quashing the advertisement No.2022106 dated 05.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.2-Punjab Public Service Commission to the extent of infringement upon the right of the petitioner to apply and be considered for selection and appointment to the post of Assistant Environmental Engineer (Group A) in respondent No.1 and for issuance of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to permit the petitioner possessing an engineering degree in Mechanical Engineering to apply and be



considered for selection and appointment to the post of Assistant Environmental Engineer (Group A).

2. On 04.09.2024 following order was passed: -

“Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.1 has produced a copy of the rules whereby qualification for the post of Assistant Environmental Engineer has been amended and as per amended qualification, petitioner is not eligible.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks adjournment to get instructions.

Adjourned to 5.9.2024.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to challenge the amendment made in the rules, whereby qualifications have been amended for the post of Assistant Environmental Engineer.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
